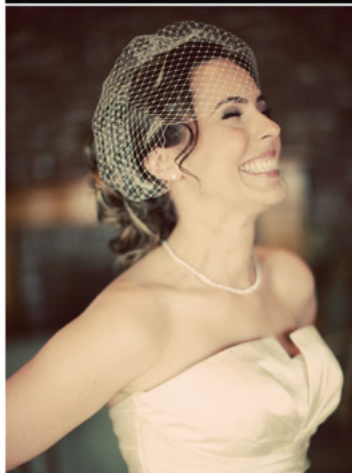


## A CUSTOM PROPOSAL
