



SAFETY GUIDELINES

We are thrilled to reopen our doors to The Spa at Semiahmoo. Before your appointment, please take a moment to review our safety guidelines below.

- All guests attending The Spa at Semiahmoo are required to complete the Covid Compliance Waiver and Health Pre-Assessment.
- The Spa will be operating under a limited schedule of Thursday - Monday 9:00 am - 6:30 pm, and will be closed Tuesday - Wednesday.
- Per Washington public health order, facial coverings are required when in public spaces where unable to physically distance from others. Guests are required to wear masks at all times at the Spa, including during all treatments. We are happy to provide a mask if needed. Spa team members will be wearing masks at all times.
- Only guests with appointments will be permitted at this time due to limited capacity. Walk-ins will not be accepted.
- Spa appointment times will be staggered and arrival process altered to ensure occupancy and social distancing guidelines are met. Please do not bring guests to your appointment.
- Health screenings and temperature checks will be conducted for Spa guests upon arrival.
- Spa guests are required to wash their hands prior to the start of a service.
- Spa therapists will be wearing masks and aprons at all times, and changing out aprons between each service.
- Spa team members will be enforcing a strict cleaning and sanitation schedule with CDC approved cleaning products.
- In order to maintain proper social distancing, the Relaxation Room, pool, hot tub, steam room, and sauna will remain closed at this time.
- Locker rooms can be used for hand washing and restrooms only.
- Guests under the age of 18 are not permitted at this time.
- We will not be providing towels at this time.
- We ask that Spa guests practice physical distancing at all times with other guests.
- Please refrain from visiting The Spa if you or a household member has displayed any COVID-19 symptoms or if you are under an isolation or quarantine order/directive.
- We kindly ask that you respect all aforementioned safety guidelines, as well as standards and processes posted on site and shared by employees.
