CANADIAN COVID-19 TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS FAQ

What are the requirements for Canadian border travel to the United States?

- Adults 18 years and over will need to confirm, or show proof, that they are [fully vaccinated](#)
- Children under the age of 18 are exempt

Do I need to show a molecular (PCR) test to enter the United States or re-enter Canada?

- You do not need to provide a negative test to enter the United States

Do I need to show a molecular or PCR test to re-enter Canada?

- Yes, you will need to take a pre-entry test in the United States in order to return home.
 - A pre-entry molecular test is required for all travelers. A rapid antigen test will not be accepted.
- You must present an accepted negative molecular test result (paper or electronic proof)

U.S./AMERICAN COVID-19 TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS FAQ

What are the vaccination requirements for U.S./American travel to Canada?

- Those 12 years and older will need to confirm, or show proof, that they are fully vaccinated
- See link regarding requirements for [unvaccinated dependents](#)
- Children 5 and under are exempt
- Upload proof of vaccination in [ArriveCAN](#)
- You cannot have symptoms of COVID-19 and might be selected for a random arrival test

Do I need to show a molecular or PCR test to enter Canada?

- U.S. travelers 5 years of age or older, regardless of vaccination status, must provide proof of a COVID-19 negative molecular or PCR test result taken within 72 hours of their arrival to Canada
- You must present an accepted negative molecular test result (paper or electronic proof)
- To re-enter the United States, you do not need to provide a negative test
